New Calling System Approved

The Finance Committee has approved the "One Call Now" calling system to be used as a means of communicating important last minute messages with the entire parish (or with a select group). This would include, but not limited to, funeral arrangements, changes in the Mass schedule, urgent messages from the pastor, etc. Different ministries would be given access to this to contact their members about meeting changes and reminders; CCD and Youth Group can use this to get last minute reminders out to parents; RCIA can use it for meeting changes; etc. We are excited about this new program and all the possibilities there are for communicating with you. And Yes, it replaces the need for anyone to have to call others, no more Phone Tree! If you don't answer the call, the system will leave a message on your answering machine; if you do not have an answering machine, it will continue to call throughout the day. We will receive a report back so we know who received the message. It also gives everyone the option at the end of every message to opt-out of receiving any future calls. But we need help setting this up. Please reply to the email you will receive next week with the ONE phone number to be the contact for YOUR household. You can also let us know if you want to be notified about last minute WEEKDAY Mass changes, or if you prefer not to receive any phone notifications at this time. If you don't have an email, we already have your phone number of preference on the old phone tree list. Please be sure to always update your phone numbers with us when they change, or if you cancel your landline and go to a cell phone only.
