"OneCallNow" Calling System

We have used the new calling system to relay messages a couple of times now. If anyone has any questions, wants us to use a different phone number, or wants to opt-out of calls altogether, please call the Church Office and leave a message on the answering machine, we will be glad to honor your request.

On one recent call, several of you called the Church Office leaving a message that you missed a call from us. If that happens, please check your answering machines before calling the church, as there may be a message waiting.

We have found the system isn't perfect. There have been a few glitches when the message was left on an answering machine, ie: the system began to record the message before a long greeting had finished, or a few words spoken before the message began from the beginning, etc. If you don't hear the entire message, or for another reason need it to be replayed, simply call the toll free **OneCallNow** phone number and follow the prompts. (You'll find the number permanently on the inside cover of the bulletin in the box where the Office Phone # and parish website are listed.) Be sure to call the **OneCallNow** number *from the phone # we have listed for you in the system so it will recognize you.* Thank you for your patience as we all get used to

this new system.
