Lent Begins This Week

We will have Mass & distribution of Ashes on Wednesday, February 26th, at 6pm. During Lent, **Stations of the Cross** will be held on Fridays at 5pm.

A reminder from the "Arkansas Catholic":

- Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fast & abstinence. The law of **fasting** obliges all between the ages of 18-59 and allows one full meal & two smaller ones. The obligation of **abstinence** begins at age 14 and prohibits the eating of meat.
- Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
- Parents are to see minors are encouraged to do penance suitable to their age.
- All members of the Christian faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during Lent beyond what's prescribed by Law.

Friday Lenten Meals

Following Stations of the Cross on February 28th & March 13th, the Knights of Columbus will offer a Fish Fry (Adults are \$8; children ages 6-12 are \$6, and ages 5 and under are free). On March 20th & April 3rd, the Altar Society will coordinate a Soup Meal following Stations (signup sheets for soup donations will be in the vestibule in early March).

Arkansas Missions
